

GUIDED TOURS AT DARTS HILL GARDEN

We welcome garden clubs and other groups to have a guided tour of the garden

- Tours are booked for two hours
- Tours are available for groups of six or more
- Volunteer guides will meet you in the parking lot, rain or shine. Please dress for the weather. Good walking shoes are recommended. We aim to provide one volunteer guide per 6-12 people.
- The garden paths are packed gravel, but most are not suitable for wheelchairs, scooters, strollers, or other devices used by those who have difficulty walking. That said, there are many benches to rest and enjoy a quiet moment.
- Keep on the paths so as not to disturb bulbs, seedlings or plants we may be propagating. No cuttings or seeds may be taken.
- You may bring a snack to enjoy on a bench or blanket in the pasture. There are picnic tables in Maple Meadows, near the house.
- Your vehicles must clear the parking lot at the end of the two-hour time that is booked for your tour.
- Darts Hill Garden Park is 22 acres. The tour is of the 7.5 acre historic garden.
