Casual & Tourist Photography

You are encouraged to take casual and tourist photos in Darts Hill Garden Park. Please note that drones, luggage, large equipment, and costumes are not permitted. Please review and abide by our Garden Etiquette and Rules as noted below whenever you are taking casual photos at Darts Hill Garden Park.

Garden Etiquette and Rules

- Photographers cannot block paths or access to any areas of the Park.
- No staged photography and no props.
- Stay on pathways and mowed lawn areas. Do not walk in mulched or planted garden beds.
- Please leave flowers and plants for everyone to enjoy. Do not collect or remove seeds, flowers, fruits, plant labels, etc.
- No smoking in city parks; i.e. no cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or cannabis.
- No sports equipment is allowed in the garden.
- No climbing, running, sports, or games of any kind.
- For their safety, always supervise children.
- Do not wade or swim in the pond or streams.
- No pets. Service dogs/animals are permitted.
- Do not feed or handle the wildlife. It can be harmful to them and you.
- Please dispose of waste in bins.
- Shirts and shoes are always required.
- No alcohol or use of firearms.
- For safety, please always keep your personal items with you. The Darts Hill Garden Conservancy Trust Society and the City of Surrey cannot be held responsible for missing items. If you recover an item in the Park that does not belong to you, please turn it in to the Information Desk.
- We reserve the right to stop any activity that interferes with others' enjoyment of the Park.

Staged photography (Wedding, Engagement or Personal Promotional Photography)

Please be advised that **staged photography**, be it wedding, engagement, or Personal Promotional Photography – considered to be a staged photoshoot of a group, such as a family gathering, reunion, or special occasion – **is not permitted**.
